

Personalize Your Brewpub Growler

To personalize your Brewpub Growler.



For the above, I used a 50 foot length of 3/16 " line. ~\$2.50 at the local hardware store. Here we go:

1. Lay out your line and make a double wrap around the neck of the Growler. Twist the two together. Finish with a Square knot (Reef Bend). I put a Half Hitch to finish it and cut the end flush.



2. Start the First Hitch on the Neck.



3. Pull the lead through and tie a Hitch.



4. Pull the Hitch through and tighten it up. Leave a loop about 2 inches. If there is a handle, loop around it as shown.



5. For this one, I did ten Hitches round in a circle. The last one should span the original Square knot (Reef Bend). If the neck is thinner or thicker, adjust accordingly.



6. When you come around to the beginning after the tenth Hitch, drop down about an inch-and-a-half. And make a Sheet Bend to the first loop.



7. Keep going around, maintaining the same depth of the row loops.



8. Each time you return to the beginning of the row loop, drop the loop to a lower level to start the next row. When there is a bit of each loop on the last row hanging over the edge of the Growler, it is time to finish.



9. Come through each loop and Pull the ring tight.



10. Go around in an over/under weave three times. It will form a nice rope base.



11. You'll notice that there is a gap where you dropped the loops at the end of each row that extends right up to the neck. If you have done three complete rings on the bottom, you should be at that gap. Come back up to the neck using a Clove Hitch at the crossing of each rope.

12. When you get back to the neck, make one last Hitch and leave a bit for a Stopper knot. I put in a Monkey's Fist.
